

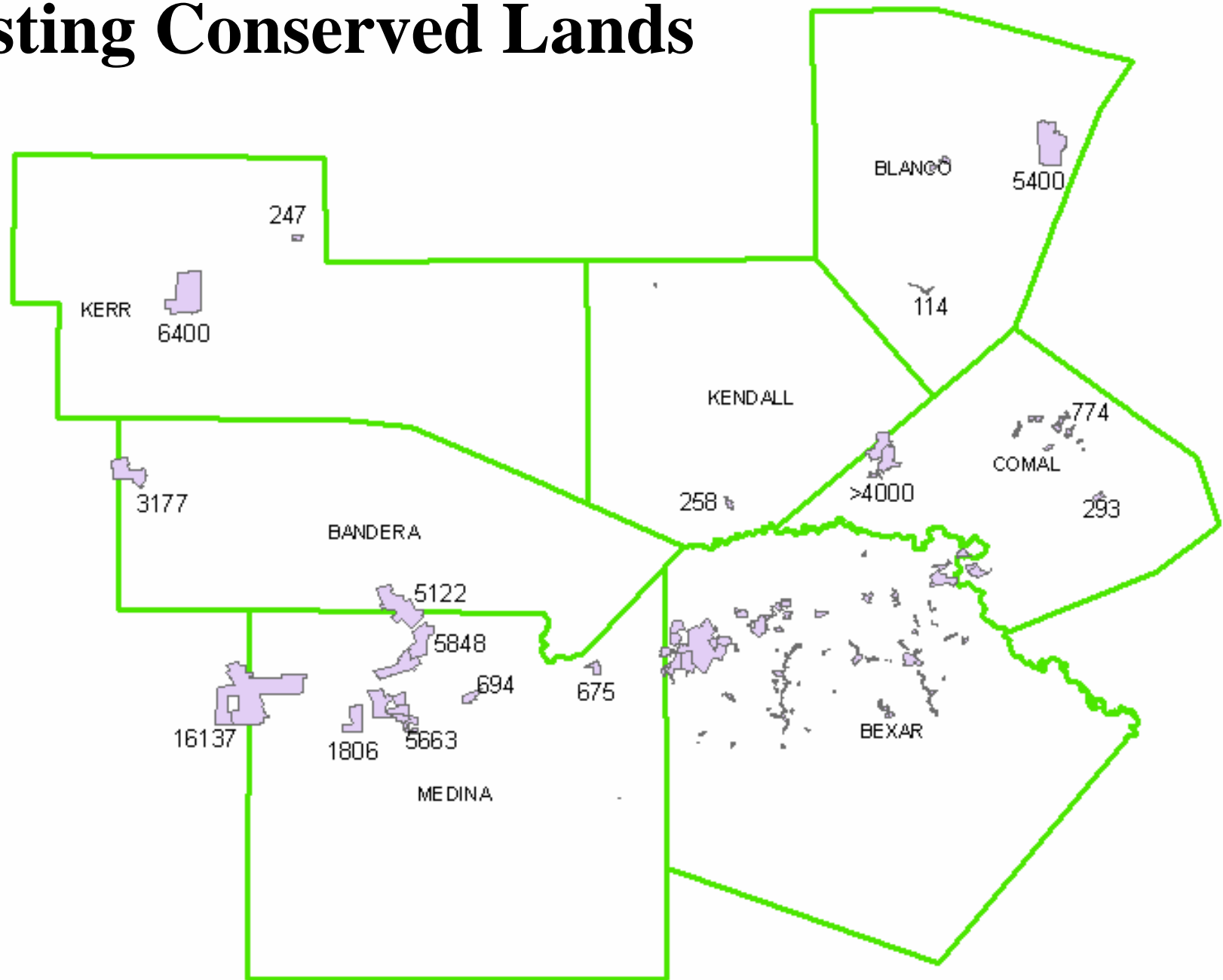
Assumptions

- **For warblers, we don't want to activate Chapter 83 (No maps or overly specific verbage)**
- **Our current recommendation is 85,000– 100,000 acres**
- **We can make both goals and requirements**
- **It may be prudent to provide flexibility by only prescribing part of the Preserve System**
- **Focal areas may be anchored to existing protected lands**

Starting Point 1

- Suggest 5,000-10,000 acre focal areas
- Require 4 focal areas in and around Bexar County
 - One of these must be largely within Bexar
- Suggest at least 1 focal area in all counties but Blanco
 - Lack of Blanco County habitat would result in green-lining.
- Remaining mitigation should strive to connect focal areas and existing protected lands
- To meet focal area goals, existing conservation lands can be included (*)

Existing Conserved Lands



Starting Point 2

- Suggest properties be grouped in 5,000 acre blocks as much as possible.
- Require 15,000 additional acres conserved in Bexar County
- Remaining mitigation should strive to connect focal areas and existing protected lands
- Use existing protected areas as anchors for Preserve

CAC Requests

- Preference for lands over Edwards Aquifer (C & R)
- Anchor Preserves with existing protected lands
- Target as many smaller tracts as possible b/c it's easier to obtain smaller lands
- Target large tracts b/c they're easier to manage
